There is a two-year limitation on the Division taking action on student complaints.

The College's policy regarding postponement of starting date and the effect on student's right to a refund:

"Postponement of a starting date, whether at the request of the college or the student, requires a written agreement signed by the student and the college. The agreement must set forth:

- a. Whether the postponement is for the convenience of the college or the student, and:
- b. A deadline for the new start date, beyond which the start date will not be postponed.

If the course is not commenced, or the student fails to attend by the new start date set forth in the agreement, the student will be entitled to an appropriate refund of prepaid tuition and fees within 30 days of the deadline of the new start date set forth in the agreement, determined in accordance with the school's refund policy and all applicable laws and rules concerning the Private Occupational Education Act of 1981. The college will provide a full refund if education service is discontinued by the college, EXCEPT IF THE COLLEGE CEASES OPERATION
