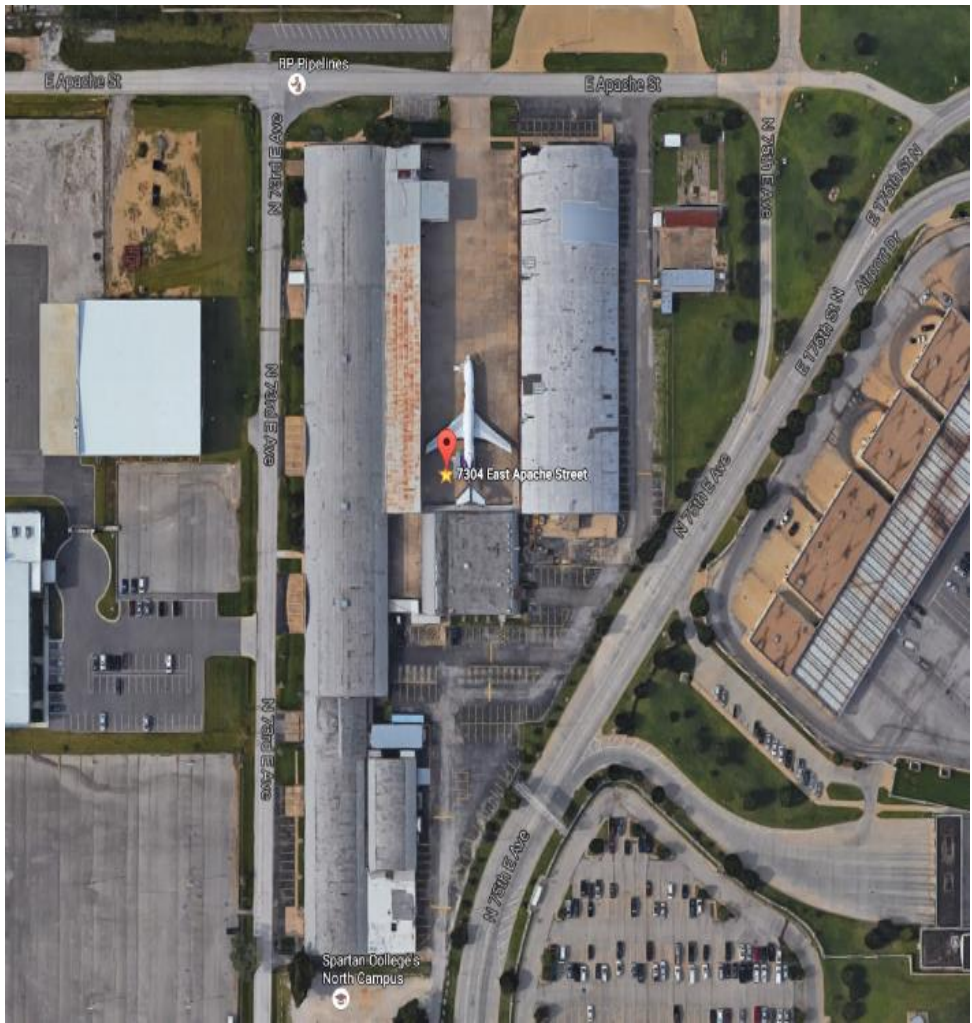
Parking for all industry partners will be located between Building 8 and Building 10 in front of the Federal Express 727 Airplane

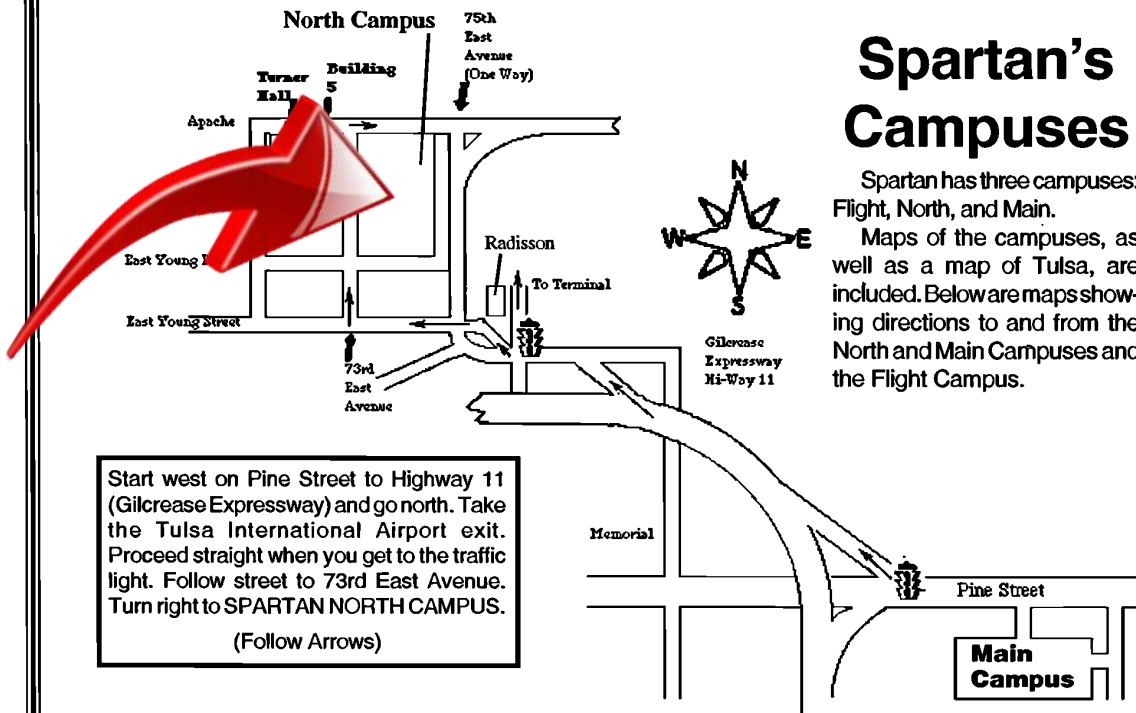


MAPS TO SPARTAN FACILITIES

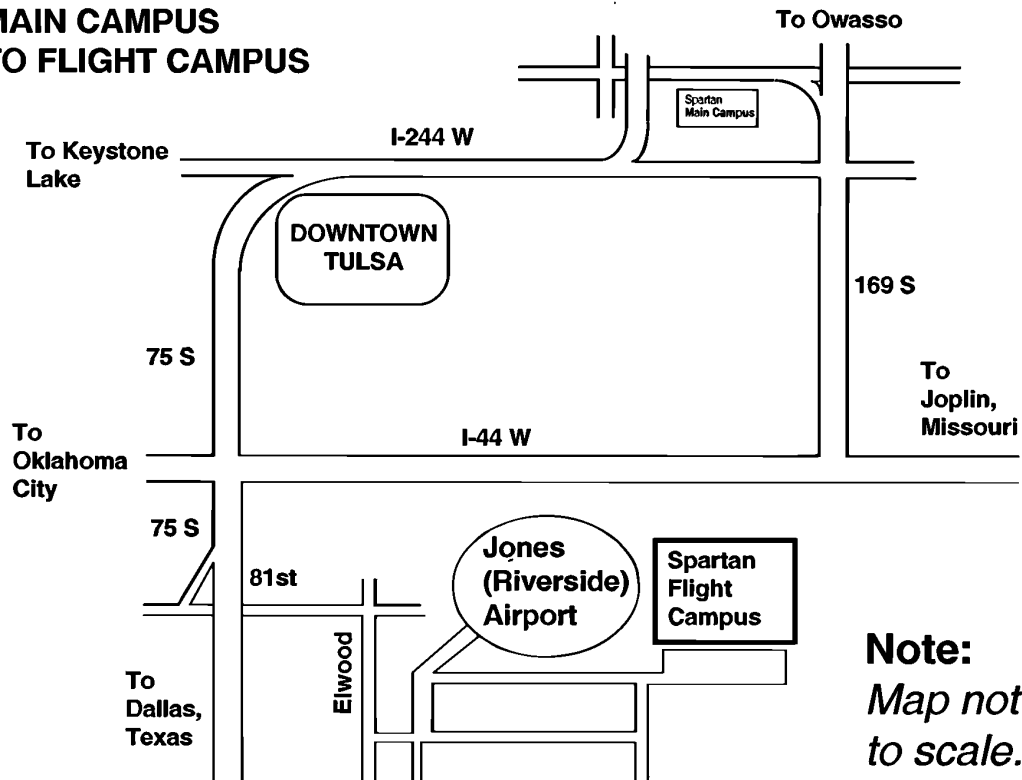
Spartan's Campuses

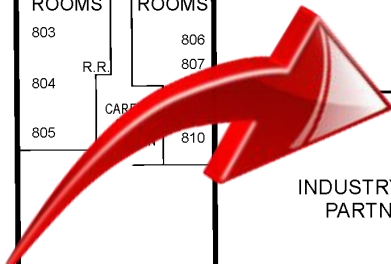
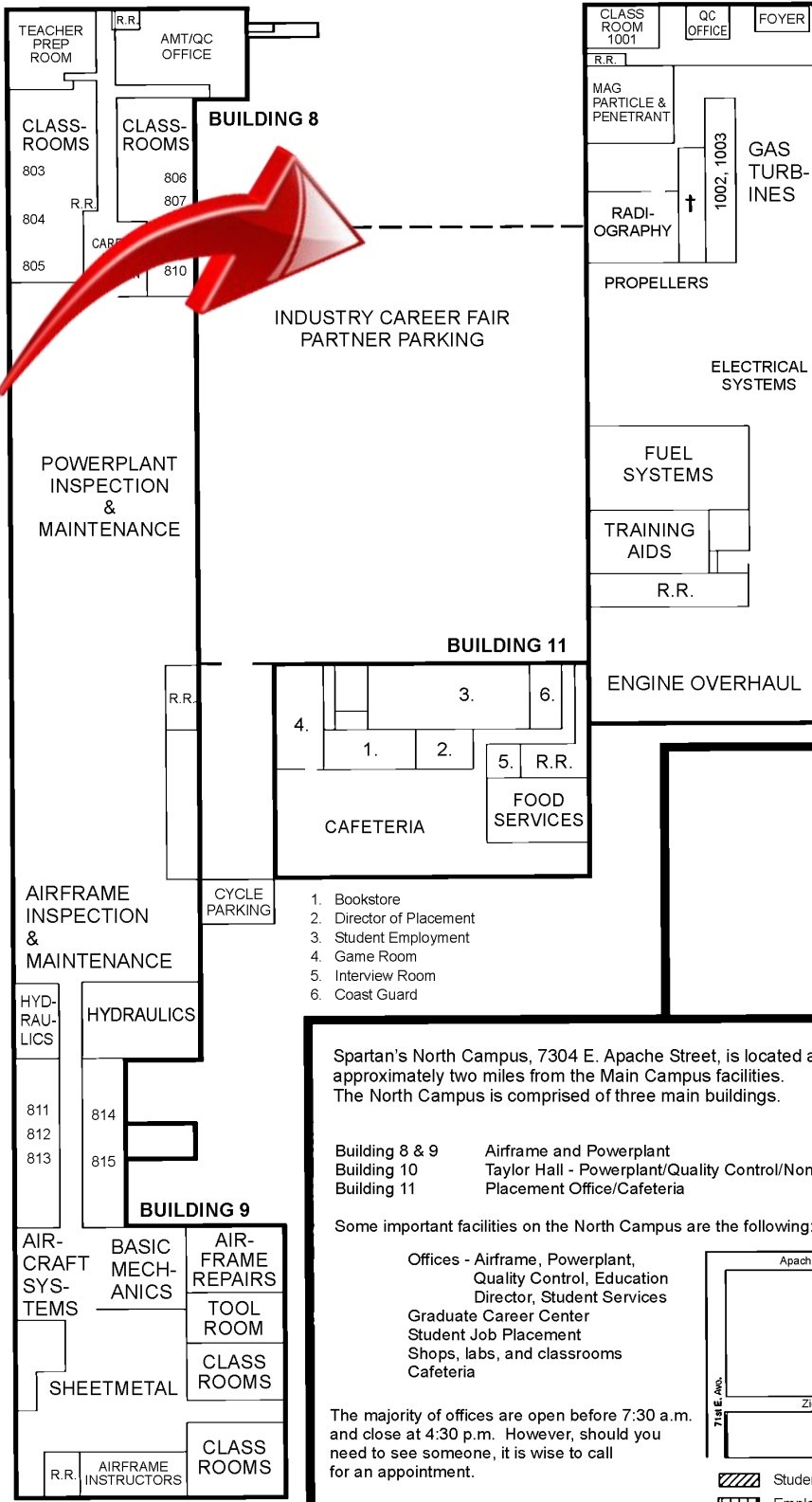
Spartan has three campuses: Flight, North, and Main.

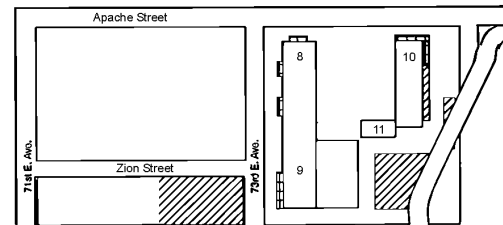
Spartan's North Campus, 7304 E. Apache Street, is located at the Tulsa International Airport, approximately two miles from the Main Campus facilities. The North Campus is comprised of three main buildings.

- Building 8 & 9 Airframe and Powerplant
- Building 10 Taylor Hall - Powerplant/Quality Control/Nondestructive Testing
- Building 11 Placement Office/Cafeteria

Some important facilities on the North Campus are the following:

- Offices - Airframe, Powerplant, Quality Control, Education Director, Student Services
- Graduate Career Center
- Student Job Placement
- Shops, labs, and classrooms
- Cafeteria

The majority of offices are open before 7:30 a.m. and close at 4:30 p.m. However, should you need to see someone, it is wise to call for an appointment.
