Amounts awarded: Six scholarships/\$1,500 each.

Scholarship Description: The Comanche Flyer Foundation, a charitable organization that operates exclusively for charitable, scientific and education purposes, awards scholarships each year in varying amounts to students training for the General Aviation Maintenance FAA Certification.

The Scholarships will be awarded to students who are dedicated to supporting general aviation maintenance.

Purpose: To provide funding to students who are enrolled in accredited aviation maintenance A & P Technician Certification programs at an approved FAR Part 147 Aviation Maintenance Technician School.

Scholarship Criteria: Applicants must be citizens of the U.S. and officially enrolled in, or accepted for enrollment in an accredited A&P program approved by FAR Part 147 School. Requirements: Complete an Application; provide two reference statements from colleagues, employers, faculty members or other individuals who are familiar with applicant's abilities; and provide proof of enrollment in the accredited A&P program. These scholarships will be awarded to applicants who are enrolled in the Spring 2014 semester.

Comanche Flyer Foundation General Aviation Maintenance Scholarship Application

The Comanche Flyer Foundation's bylaws state that it is a corporation that shall operate exclusively for charitable, scientific and educational purposes. Its mission is to promote educational, scientific and safety concerns related to Piper Comanche aircraft.

The Comanche Flyer Foundation annually awards scholarships to applicants pursuing careers as maintenance technicians. The scholarships benefit students who currently are enrolled in or who have been accepted for enrollment in an accredited airframe and powerplant (A&P) program at an approved FAR Part 147 school. This year we will be awarding six (6) scholarships in the amount of \$1,500 each.

Awards will be made to U.S. citizens without regard to sex, race, religion or national origin. All applications will be received and reviewed up to November 1, 2013, and scholarships will be awarded by January 1, 2014 for the Spring 2014 semester.

Application Requirements

- 1. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen, and proof will be required.**
- 2. At the time of application, applicant either must be officially enrolled or accepted for enrollment in an accredited A&P program as per FAR Part 147. Proof of enrollment or acceptance of enrollment, such as an official transcript or letter of acceptance, must be provided prior to the distribution of the award.**
- 3. A completed application consists of: applicant's personal, educational and aviation experience; completed applicant statement; and two reference statements.**
- 4. Completed application and required documents must be postmarked no later than November 1, 2013 to be considered for the scholarship.**
- 5. Applicant agrees that the scholarship monies will be sent to the program/school in which said applicant is enrolled or accepted, which monies will then be applied toward the applicant's tuition/program costs. If tuition is less than the award, the excess may be applied toward supplies/textbooks the applicant must purchase and/or fees for certification.**
