**Note: The following fees need to be added to the total program cost for international students:** (1) \$2,000 International Student Fee. \*Spartan International Scholarship may be available to those that qualify. (See International Student Requirements in the General Catalog.) After receiving the I-20A-B form the student needs to pay the SEVIS-I-901 fee of \$200 prior to the VISA interview with the American Embassy or Consulate.

All tuition and program lengths are based on a student attending the full program for which he or she is enrolled. An academic year for the Technical College is defined as completion of 900 clock hours. The satisfactory completion of the clock hours in the academic year is necessary before a student may progress to the next level of academic standing.
