### **B.S. DEGREE IN TECHNOLOGY MANAGEMENT (HYBRID)**

At Spartan College, we understand the need for our students to complete their bachelor's degree in a convenient format. That is why we offer two bachelor's programs. Both programs include the same coursework; however, one program is delivered 100% online\* through distance education, and the other program is a hybrid format that includes both on-ground courses in Tulsa, OK and online\* courses. The Bachelor of Science in Technology Management (BSTM) programs are designed for students who wish to strengthen their business and management acumen within technical industries.

### **WHO IS THIS DEGREE DESIGNED FOR?**

As part of the admissions requirements, students need previously earned credits and/or certifications that meet the College's transfer policy to satisfy 30 technical elective credits. Once accepted, the 30 elective credits reduce program length from 31 months to 23 months.

## SAMPLE CLASSES

Students combine their previous technical training and experience with communication, quantitative reasoning, and critical thinking, as well as business management. This blend of training, experience, and education in our Technology Management degree offers an opportunity to increase your knowledge and management skills and prepare for challenges in the field.



### MGT 3001 FUNDAMENTALS OF MANAGEMENT 3 SEMESTER CREDITS

This course is an introduction to management principles and techniques with a view toward developing essential skills in the field. Both the history of management and contemporary issues will be discussed as well as viewing real world case studies .



### MGT 4003 INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS PRACTICES 3 SEMESTER CREDITS

An in-depth study of managerial practices needed for business in today's global marketplace. Subject areas include managerial theory and several special topics including a global perspective on management in the world economy. Case studies illustrating managerial problems and solutions are widely used.

## BACHELOR'S DEGREE PREREQUISITES

In addition to the standard admission requirements, to enroll in a bachelor's program, technical students (non-flight) are required to have a diploma/degree completed with 30 technical electives eligible for transfer, and be working in or have previous experience in that technical field. Flight students must have private pilot certification completed and be currently enrolled in a flight training program leading to Certified Flight Instructor (CFI) rating.

Spartan can evaluate previously earned Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) certifications to determine whether Prior Learning Credits may be awarded. Please refer to the College Catalog for more information or speak with our campus representatives to find out more.
